ANNA QUINDLEN AND BRIDGET MOYNAHAN HEADLINE WOMEN'S DAY AT THE TRAVELERS CHAMPIONSHIP ON JUNE 21

She previously worked at The New York Times, where she won a Pulitzer Prize for Commentary. She also worked for more than a decade at Newsweek, writing the popular bi-weekly column "Thinking Out Loud."

Moynahan has been a model for more than two decades and began her illustrious acting career in 1999. She has appeared in several popular movies, including "I, Robot," "Sex and the City," "Coyote Ugly," "Serendipity," and "The Recruit." Her most recent success was the blockbuster hit "Battle: Los Angeles," where she starred alongside Aaron Eckhart and Michelle Rodriguez. She currently stars in the CBS drama "Blue Bloods."
