RENOWNED JOURNALIST NORAH O'DONNELL AND TONY-NOMINATED BROADWAY STAR CHRISTOPHER JACKSON TO HEADLINE 2018 TRAVELERS CHAMPIONSHIP WOMEN'S DAY

Christopher Jackson is best known for starring as George Washington in the original cast of "Hamilton," earning a Tony Award nomination. Other Broadway appearances have been in "Holler If Ya Hear Me," "After Midnight," "The Bronx Bombers," "In the Heights," "Memphis" and "The Lion King." Jackson can currently be seen in the CBS drama "Bull," playing the character of Chunk. He won a Grammy Award for his song with Will.I.Am called ""What I Am," and earned an Emmy Award for his work as the composer/songwriter for "Sesame Street."
