### **CREDENTIAL PACKAGE**

All amateur participants and caddies will receive a digital ticket for the day of their Pro-Am. This digital ticket will allow them access to the Pro-Am Valet, located in the Gray Lot, as well as access to enter the tournament grounds. Once through security, participants and caddies will be asked to check-in at our Pro-Am Check-In Trailer where they will receive a Pro-Am badge to be used while on course.

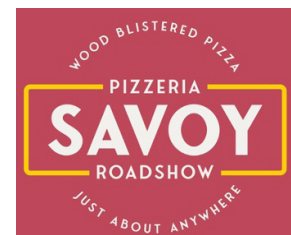
### **DRESS CODE**

We ask that all Pro-Am participants and their caddies wear a collared shirt along with non-denim shorts or long pants. Please also note TPC River Highlands has a no metal spike policy.

### **FOOD AND BEVERAGE**

Food and beverage will be available starting at 5:30 a.m. and throughout the round. All food and beverage will be “grab-n-go” style. New in 2022, Pro-Am hospitality will be hosted in the First Tee of Connecticut building, which will feature food from 3 food trucks throughout the day. The Pro-Am will feature an on-course Food Tour consisting of additional local food trucks.

## **GIFTS AND PRIZES**

New for the 2022 event, the Pro-Am Shopping Spree Experience has been grown and enhanced to include all items available in the tournament Fan Shop, as well as a couple of additional vendors specifically for the Pro-Am including:



The shopping spree will take place prior to the participants' round, so we recommend arriving with time to participate and warm up!

- Socially distanced individual photos will be taken and can be picked up by participants at the end of their round.
- First, second and third place winners will be announced virtually, and awards will be shipped direct to winning amateur participants.

## **MAXIMUM AMATEUR SCORE**

Each team is requested to play at a reasonable pace, no slower than 15 minutes per hole, or four and 1/2 hours for the round, and to keep up with the group in front of them. Amateurs cannot score higher than a net par on any hole.

## **PARKING**

Upon arrival at TPC River Highlands, all participants and caddies must have their digital Pro-Am pass available to show to the on-site parking team. All participants and caddies should follow signs to the GRAY LOT. Participants and caddies will then continue to the parking area where they can drop off their golf bags and have their car valeted. After parking, participants and caddies will be directed through security to the Pro-Am Check-In Trailer. Please note there will be no Pro-Am access via Golf Club Road.

## **PRACTICE FACILITY**

The TPC River Highlands practice facility will be open for use for those who are registered to play in the Pro-Am. The practice facility will be open between the hours of 5:50 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.

## **PRO-AM CADDIES**

As a participant in an on-site Pro-Am, amateurs have the option of bringing an amateur caddie to share in the Pro-Am experience with them, or the host organization may provide one. If an amateur chooses not to bring an amateur caddie and the host organization does not provide one, the amateur will be provided with a volunteer caddie.

## **PRO-AM FORMAT**

The Travelers Celebrity Pro-Am will be a tee-time start. All amateurs will play from the tournament tees. The format is best ball; everyone plays his or her own ball from tee to green. The best individual score for the hole is taken as the group score. The PGA TOUR professional will keep the official scorecard.

In the event of a playoff, all ties will be broken with a scorecard play-off starting at hole 18 and working backwards.

## **REGISTRATION**

All amateur participants must complete their registration through the tournament's Trust Event platform by Wednesday, June 1, 2022.



## SUSPENSION OF PLAY PROCEDURES

When play is suspended for dangerous weather and the players in a group are between the play of two holes, they shall not resume play until the Tournament Staff has ordered a resumption of play. If the players are in the process of playing a hole, they shall discontinue play immediately. A suspension for dangerous weather shall be signaled by one prolonged siren or horn note.

All other types of suspension for non-dangerous weather shall be signaled by several short intermittent siren or horn notes. Penalty for breach of this condition: Disqualification. In the event of inclement or dangerous weather, or other conditions beyond the control of the Travelers Championship or the PGA TOUR, in which the commencement or continuation of the Pro-Am is deemed impractical, then in any such events, the Pro-Am may be delayed, postponed, shortened, or canceled, whichever may be deemed appropriate by the Travelers Championship Tournament Director, or his designee; and, the Travelers Championship shall have no obligation to refund any portion of the entry fee remitted here with the reason of any such postponement, rescheduling or cancellation.

## TEE TIMES

Amateurs will be invited to partake in a pairings event in order to determine their group's professional and tee time. More information on the pairings event will be shared soon. Groups will go off 1 and 10 with tee times from 6:50 a.m. to 8:50 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. The round will be played in a Best Ball Format.
