



VOLUNTEER CODE OF CONDUCT

The Travelers Championship appreciates your commitment and interest in volunteering at the 2023 event. Volunteers are subject to verification of eligibility by background and/or reference checks at the option of the Travelers Championship. The tournament expects its volunteers to conduct themselves with courtesy and professionalism and to remember that every person at the tournament, whether they are a player, volunteer or patron, deserves to be treated with consideration and respect. The tournament expects that all volunteers will be guided by this principle while volunteering at tournament events or representing the tournament in public. Therefore, the tournament offers these guidelines on how to conduct yourself, either on the grounds of the event or wherever you might be representing the tournament while in your volunteer uniform. Please note, this list is illustrative and not exhaustive of the behavior the tournament expects of its volunteers.

A VOLUNTEER MUST:

- Wear the appropriate tournament approved uniform at all times while volunteering;
- Treat all patrons, players, fans, employees and fellow volunteers with courtesy and respect;
- · Abide by all tournament policies and procedures;
- Follow all safety recommendations and protocols set by the tournament, CDC guidelines, and the PGA TOUR;
- · Fulfill shift minimum requirements;
- Complete all shifts assigned unless otherwise communicated with the tournament or Committee Chair;
- Perform all tasks and duties asked by the Committee Chair;
- Be punctual.
- Read, be familiar with and agree to abide by the PGA TOUR Volunteer Integrity Program, which prohibits volunteers from betting on the Tournament.

A VOLUNTEER MUST NOT:

- Consume alcohol or be under the influence of alcohol while in uniform:
- Smoke or be under the influence of any chemical or drugs;
- · Violate any applicable law, regulation or ordinance;
- Engage in any type of discriminatory or harassing behavior on the basis of race, color, religion, gender, age, national origin, disability, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity, veteran status, military status, genetic information or any other status or condition protected by local, state or federal law;
- · Allow another individual to use your volunteer credentials;
- Seek autographs in alignment with the PGA TOUR autograph policy, solicit gratuities, gifts or bequests for personal or professional benefit;
- Enter restricted areas without proper credentials;
- · Leave tasks or posts unattended;
- Use vulgar or offensive language;
- Resell tickets, credentials or tournament merchandise.

If you are aware of, or suspect, conduct that is unlawful or violates this Code of Conduct or tournament policies and procedures, please notify Taylor Whiting at volunteers@travelerschampionship.com.

A violation of this Code of Conduct may lead to immediate revocation of your volunteer credentials, expulsion from the tournament grounds and prevent you from volunteering at future events.

ADA PARKING

Parking for spectators with disabilities will be available at Woodside Intermediate School (GPS Address: 30 Woodside Road, Cromwell, CT) for vehicles with a valid state permit. A complimentary wheelchair accessible shuttle will also be available from the lot to the main entrance from Monday, June 19 – Sunday, June 25.

Shuttle runs from 7 a.m. - 7 p.m. *Open Monday & Tuesday for working staff only

There will be two ADA viewing locations on-site on hole 9 and 18 green as well as bleacher locations.

ARRIVAL

Please arrive on course with enough time before your shift to park, check-in, grab your breakfast, and walk to your committee meeting area. All volunteers will enter the **Volunteer Headquarters at 9 Gate** and check-in at the Volunteer Check-In trailer.

Remember to be respectful of others and watch your distance while waiting in line at the Volunteer Check-In trailer. Please check in each morning you are on course as you will receive food vouchers for the day. After checking in, you may pick up your breakfast inside the Volunteer Villa and utilize the rest of the Volunteer Headquarters area.

AUTOGRAPH POLICY

To enhance the autograph experience, while allowing players to properly prepare for competition, the PGA TOUR has established the following guidelines:

- Autographs can only be obtained at the designated Autograph Zone at the Practice Facility
- On-course autographs are not permitted. This includes, but not limited to, tees, fairways, greens and practice areas and practice areas during practice and tournament rounds
- No memorabilia can be brought into the tournament including pin flags, photos, trading cards, balls and other sports paraphernalia

As a reminder, volunteers are not permitted to ask for autographs while volunteering and in uniform.

CREDENTIALS & PARKING

All volunteer credentials will be digital, including parking passes. The volunteer digital credential is valid every day, Wednesday-Sunday, including days not volunteering.

"Inside the ropes" committees will receive a badge in your package that will allow "inside the ropes" access during volunteer shifts. All volunteers with this badge must keep it visible at all times.

PARKING

All volunteers will be parking in the **Volunteer Lot (Pink Lot)**. Please follow all directional signage to the Volunteer Lot. Once you have turned onto the below GPS address, you will bear right at the first split. <u>Do NOT go to the Gold Lot.</u>

Your digital volunteer credential will also function as your parking pass for the day of your shift. Just show your digital credential at the Volunteer Lot (Pink Lot) for parking. Volunteers will then proceed to the Volunteer Headquarters, which is located near 9 Gate.

EMERGENCIES

If an emergency occurs, please dial 911 and notify the committee chair, a hole captain or staff member closest to you. They will radio the nearest Saint Francis Hospital Medical Center medical personnel if applicable.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

BREAKFAST

- At the Check-In trailer each morning, volunteers will receive a breakfast voucher that will be able to be redeemed inside the Volunteer Villa tent only.
- Breakfast on Monday & Tuesday will be served from 6AM-10AM and from 5AM-10AM on Wednesday through Sunday.
- Breakfast items include a choice of bagel, muffin, and hot breakfast sandwich, along with whole fruit and greek yogurt. A gluten free option is available daily upon request.

LUNCH

- At the Check-In trailer each morning, volunteers will receive a lunch voucher to be used at
 concession stands around the golf course. Please remember that the meal vouchers are day
 specific and cannot be redeemed for alcohol or apparel. Please see the back of the voucher for
 additional redemption details and locations.
- If you are apart of the Location Based Operators or Spotter committees, you will exchange your voucher with the committee chair and your meal will be delivered to your volunteer location on the golf course.

WATER AND SNACKS

- Bottled water and snacks are available in the Volunteer Villa, as well as with the Volunteer Services committee who will be available on carts around course.
- · Refillable water coolers are not available around course.
- Reusable plastic or metals cups/bottles are permitted if they are empty upon arrival. Please note, there will be no refillable water stations around course.

GOLF CARTS

Any volunteer using a cart should use caution as to not interfere with play in any manner. Always operate with caution! Watching play while on a golf cart is strictly prohibited. Please follow all cart enforcements and policies throughout tournament week.

All volunteers operating a golf cart must be at least 18 years old, have watched the video and signed the golf cart waiver.

GOLF ETIQUETTE

- •Please be quiet when gallery management ambassadors raise their hands prior to any shot.
- •Please wait for the gallery management ambassadors's signal before crossing any fairways.
- •Please refrain from moving or walking when a player is preparing to hit a shot.
- •Please respect the player's concentration and do not speak with them while on course.
- •Unless instructed otherwise, please stay outside the ropes.

HELPFUL HINTS

- •Bring bug spray and sunscreen.
- •Display your credential at all times.
- •Drink plenty of fluids!
- •Wear your volunteer hat or visor for protection from the sun.
- •Treat every guest and volunteer of the tournament with the utmost kindness and respect.

LOST AND FOUND

MEDICAL

Medical Headquarters is located between the 9th Green and the Clubhouse. Medical services are provided by Saint Francis Hospital. There are satellite medical locations at holes 5/6, 12 and the 17 green side of the Fan Zone.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS

Unfortunately, there are no locations for volunteers to store their personal belongings. We recommend that anything of value be left at home. Volunteers are allowed to bring in a bag that complies with our updated security policy.

PUBLIC RESTROOMS

Public Restrooms are located throughout the course and are marked on the course map.

SECURITY POLICY

Due to recent events and heightened security across our nation, the PGA TOUR and the Travelers Championship have updated the Security Policy to include mandatory screening of all patrons, sponsors, volunteers, media and vendors attending or working the event.

Officials are asking everyone to participate in making the event safe and enjoyable by being aware of their surroundings during their visit to a PGA TOUR event. Should a person see an activity that might be unusual or suspicious, they're urged to notify security personnel or Tournament Official working the event.

Everyone is urged to keep a simple phrase in mind: "See something, say something."

Since the safety and well-being of everyone is of the utmost importance, please adhere to standard tournament policies. Listed below is the outline of the policies and procedures that will be enforced at the Travelers Championship.

Bag Inspection

All items are subject to search. Item inspection will be performed at all Admission Gates while gates are open.

The following bags are **PERMITTED** on tournament grounds:

Medically Necessary and Infant Diaper Bags



Prohibited Items

The following items are **PROHIBITED** at the Travelers Championship and must be returned to your vehicle:

Beverages or Coolers of Any Kind

Cameras (Thurs - Sun) & Lens Larger than 6" (Wednesday)



Camera Bags



Chair Bags



Clear Backpack



Clear Tote Bags, Plastic, Vinyl or Other Carry Items Larger than 12" x 6" x 12" (In their natural state)



Computers or Laptops



Drones, Remote-Controlled Model Aircrafts or other devices that can be operated in airspace



Fireworks, Laser Pointers or Other Explosives



Knives, Firearms or Weapons of Any Kind



Lounge or Over-sized Chairs with Extended Foot Rests



Memorabilia including Pin Flags, Photos,Trading Cards, Balls and Other Sports Paraphernalia



Mesh Synch Bag



Motorcycles, Mopeds, Tricycles, Bicycles, Skateboards or Hoverboards



Opaque Bags Larger than 6" x 6" x 6" (In their natural state)



Outside Food or Beverage (Except for Medical or Infant Needs)



Pets (with the exception of Service Animals)



Plastic, Metal or Glass Cups, Cans or Containers



Posters, Signs, Banners or Ladders



Printed Pattern Plastic Bag



Radios, TV's, or Other Electronic Noise Producing Items



Seat Cushions with Carrying Case or Pockets



Selfie Sticks and GoPoles



Tinted Plastic Bag



Video Cameras



Whistles, Horns or Noise Makers

Other prohibited items include:

Any other illegal substances or items deemed unlawful or dangerous by the PGA TOUR/Tournament Security Officials.

An exception will be made for fans needing to bring medical supplies into the tournament. These medically necessary items will be permitted after proper inspection at one of the admission gates.

Permitted Items

The following items **will be** allowed at the tournament:

1-Gallon Clear, Resealable Plastic Bag

Medically Necessary and Infant Diaper Bags



Binoculars without Case



Collapsible Chair without Chair Bag



Mobile Phones, Tablets, PDA's on Silent Mode (Please see Mobile Device Policy for more information)



Infant Supplies (Infant must be with Carrier)



Personal transportation devices for mobility aid such as a motorized wheelchair or scooter



Portable Radio with Headset



Reusable plastic or metal cups/bottles that are empty upon entry and exit and cannot hold more than 32-ounces



Seat Cushions that do not require a carrying case or that do not have pockets or compartments



Still Camera without Case & Lens Smaller than 6" (Wednesday)



Umbrella without Sleeve

UNIFORM

The Travelers Championship is a televised, professional sporting event, so it is important for our volunteers to meet the standards of professional golf.

While in uniform, volunteers **must**:

- Wear the official 2023 tournament-issued red volunteer golf polo and hat or visor
- Wear khaki-colored pants, skirts, capris or shorts of appropriate length
- Wear closed-toe footwear that is comfortable and predominantly a neutral color (black, white or tan is preferred)
- · Wear their own black rain gear, if heavy rain occurs. Red ponchos will be provided to wear over personal rain gear

While in uniform, volunteers **must not**:

- Wear denim
- Wear flip flops or sandals
- Wear branded baseball caps
- Wear metal spiked golf shoes
 Smoke or vape
- Consume alcohol
- Ask for player autographs
- Use cameras
- Use cell phones for personal use

VOLUNTEER AWARDS
