

VOLUNTEER INFORMATION



CODE OF CONDUCT

The Travelers Championship appreciates your commitment and interest in volunteering at the 2024 event. Volunteers are subject to verification of eligibility by background and/or reference checks at the option of the Travelers Championship. The tournament expects its volunteers to conduct themselves with courtesy and professionalism and to remember that every person at the tournament, whether they are a player, volunteer or patron, deserves to be treated with consideration and respect. The tournament expects that all volunteers will be guided by this principle while volunteering at tournament events or representing the tournament in public. Therefore, the tournament offers these guidelines on how to conduct yourself, either on the grounds of the event or wherever you might be representing the tournament while in your volunteer uniform. Please note, this list is illustrative and not exhaustive of the behavior the tournament expects of its volunteers.

A VOLUNTEER MUST:

- Wear the appropriate tournament approved uniform at all times while volunteering;
- Treat all patrons, players, fans, employees and fellow volunteers with courtesy and respect;
- · Abide by all tournament policies and procedures;
- Follow all safety recommendations and protocols set by the tournament, CDC guidelines, and the PGA TOUR;
- · Fulfill shift minimum requirements;
- Complete all shifts assigned unless otherwise communicated with the tournament or Committee Chair;
- · Perform all tasks and duties asked by the Committee Chair;
- · Be punctual.
- Read, be familiar with and agree to abide by the PGA TOUR Volunteer Integrity Program, which prohibits volunteers from betting on the Tournament.

A VOLUNTEER MUST NOT:

- Consume alcohol or be under the influence of alcohol while in uniform;
- Smoke or be under the influence of any chemical or drugs;
- · Violate any applicable law, regulation or ordinance;
- Engage in any type of discriminatory or harassing behavior on the basis of race, color, religion, gender, age, national origin, disability, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity, veteran status, military status, genetic information or any other status or condition protected by local, state or federal law;
- Allow another individual to use your volunteer credentials;
- Seek autographs in alignment with the PGA TOUR autograph policy, solicit gratuities, gifts or bequests for personal or professional benefit;
- Enter restricted areas without proper credentials;
- Leave tasks or posts unattended;
- Use vulgar or offensive language;
- Resell tickets, credentials or tournament merchandise. The resale of any ticket, credential or tournament merchandise is strictly prohibited. The tournament reserves the right to revoke volunteer tickets and credentials that are posted for resale.

If you are aware of, or suspect, conduct that is unlawful or violates this Code of Conduct or tournament policies and procedures, please notify Taylor Whiting at volunteers@travelerschampionship.com.

A violation of this Code of Conduct may lead to immediate revocation of your volunteer credentials, expulsion from the tournament grounds and prevent you from volunteering at future events.

HEADQUARTERS, LOUNGE, AND PARKING

VOLUNTEER HEADQUARTERS

All volunteers will have access to the Volunteer Headquarters, located at 9 Gate, on days volunteering. Volunteers are required to check-in at the Volunteer Check-In Trailer at the start of each day. Upon check-in, you will receive food vouchers for the day. After checking in, you may pick up your breakfast inside the Volunteer Villa and utilize the rest of the Volunteer Headquarters area.

Please arrive on course with enough time before your shift to park, check-in, grab your breakfast, and walk to your committee meeting location.

VOLUNTEER LOUNGE (LOCATED IN FAN ZONE)

The Volunteer Lounge in the Fan Zone is as an additional space for volunteers to take breaks or enjoy lunch. Hartford HealthCare has provided upgrades for this larger space that include additional seating, phone charging, snacks, and water. The Lounge is located next to the mini-golf course.

PARKING

All volunteers will be parking in the **Volunteer Lot (Pink Lot)**. Please follow all directional signage to the Volunteer Lot (Pink Lot). Once you have turned onto the below GPS address, you will bear right at the first split. Do NOT go to the Gold Lot or Green Lot.

Your digital volunteer credential will also function as your parking pass for the day of your shift. Volunteers will then proceed to the Volunteer Headquarters, which is located near 9 Gate.



TICKETS AND CREDENTIALS


All volunteer tickets are digital and include your parking pass. Each volunteer receives:

- (1) Volunteer Digital Ticket per Day: Your volunteer digital tickets give you access to the tournament grounds on days you are volunteering and can also be used on days you are not volunteering to enjoy as a fan. The digital ticket also functions as your parking pass for those days. These digital tickets are pink.
- (1) Guest Digital Ticket per Day: In addition to the volunteer tickets in your account, you also receive one guest ticket per day to transfer to family and friends. These digital tickets are teal.


Important Notes

- Volunteer and guest tickets are a benefit of volunteering. If you are no longer able to volunteer or fail to fulfill your scheduled shifts, your tickets will be canceled, including tickets you forwarded to another person.
- The resale of any ticket or credential is strictly prohibited. The tournament reserves the right to revoke volunteer tickets and credentials that are posted for resale.
- "Inside the ropes" committees will receive a badge in your package that will allow "inside the ropes" access during volunteer shifts. All volunteers with this badge must keep it visible at all times.

SHUTTLE PROGRAM

Thanks to Hartford HealthCare, the tournament provides a volunteer golf cart shuttle to help volunteers move around course. The volunteer shuttle gives volunteers that have duties further out on-course an easy and convenient way to get to their assigned locations. The shuttle will run out of the Volunteer Headquarters each morning and will drop-off at the end of each day back at the Volunteer Headquarters. Please be considerate that the shuttle will not be able to provide rides to the parking lot.







UNIFORM





The Travelers Championship is a televised, professional sporting event, so it is important for our volunteers to meet the standards of professional golf.

While in uniform, volunteers must:

- Wear the official 2024 tournament-issued red volunteer golf polo and hat or visor
- · Wear khaki-colored pants, skirts, capris or shorts of appropriate length
- Wear closed-toe footwear that are comfortable and predominantly a neutral color (black, white or tan is preferred)
- Wear their own black rain gear, if heavy rain occurs. Red ponchos will be available at the Volunteer Check-In Trailer

While in uniform, volunteers **must not**:

- Wear denim
- · Wear flip flops or sandals
- · Wear branded baseball caps
- Wear metal spiked golf shoes
- Consume alcohol
- · Ask for player autographs
- Smoke or vape
- Use cameras
- · Use cell phones for personal use

ADA PARKING AND VIEWING LOCATIONS

Parking for spectators with disabilities will be available at Woodside Intermediate School (GPS Address: 30 Woodside Road, Cromwell, CT) for vehicles with a valid state permit. A complimentary wheelchair accessible shuttle will also be available from the lot to the main entrance from Monday, June 17 – Sunday, June 23.

Shuttle runs from 7 a.m. - 7 p.m. *Open Monday & Tuesday for working staff only

There will be two ADA viewing locations on-site on hole 9 and 18 green as well as bleacher locations.

AUTOGRAPH POLICY

To enhance the autograph experience, while allowing players to properly prepare for competition, the PGA TOUR has established the following guidelines:

- Autographs can only be obtained at the designated Autograph Zone at the Practice Facility
- On-course autographs are not permitted. This includes, but not limited to, tees, fairways, greens and practice areas and practice areas during practice and tournament rounds
- No memorabilia can be brought into the tournament including pin flags, photos, trading cards, balls and other sports paraphernalia

As a reminder, volunteers are not permitted to ask for autographs while volunteering and in uniform.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

BREAKFAST

- At the Check-In trailer each morning, volunteers will receive a breakfast voucher that is redeemable inside the Volunteer Villa tent only.
- · Breakfast hours:
 - Monday and Tuesday: 6AM-10AM
 - Wednesday: 5AM-10AM
 - Thursday-Sunday: 5:30AM-10AM
- Breakfast items include a choice of bagel, muffin, and hot breakfast sandwich, along with whole
 fruit and greek yogurt. A gluten free option is available daily upon request.

LUNCH

At the Check-In trailer each morning, volunteers will receive a lunch voucher to be used at
concession stands around the golf course. Please remember that the meal vouchers are day
specific and cannot be redeemed for alcohol or apparel. Please see the back of the voucher for
additional redemption details and locations.

WATER AND SNACKS

- Bottled water and snacks are available in the Volunteer Villa, as well as with the Volunteer Services committee who will be available on carts around course.
- Refillable water coolers are not available around course.
- Reusable plastic or metals cups/bottles are permitted if they are empty upon arrival. Please note, there will be no refillable water stations around course.
- Gluten-free and nut-free snacks will be available.

GOLF CARTS

Any volunteer using a cart should use caution as to not interfere with play in any manner. Always operate with caution! Watching play while on a golf cart is strictly prohibited. Please follow all cart enforcements and policies throughout tournament week.

All volunteers operating a golf cart must be at least 18 years old, have watched the video and signed the golf cart waiver.

GOLF ETIQUETTE

- •Please be quiet when gallery management ambassadors raise their hands prior to any shot.
- •Please wait for the gallery management ambassadors's signal before crossing any fairways.
- •Please refrain from moving or walking when a player is preparing to hit a shot.
- •Please respect the player's concentration and do not speak with them while on course.
- •Unless instructed otherwise, please stay outside the ropes.

HELPFUL HINTS

- •Bring bug spray and sunscreen.
- •Display your credential at all times.
- •Drink plenty of fluids!
- •Wear your volunteer hat or visor for protection from the sun.
- •Treat every guest and volunteer of the tournament with the utmost kindness and respect.

LOST AND FOUND

MEDICAL

Medical Services are provided by Saint Francis Hospital. There will be five medical locations on site - one between 9 green and the clubhouse, 5/6, 12, the 17 green side of the Fan Zone and 16 green behind the Mohegan Sun venue.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS

Unfortunately, there are no locations for volunteers to store their personal belongings. We recommend that anything of value be left at home. Volunteers are allowed to bring in a bag that complies with our updated security policy, which includes the clear bag you receive with your volunteer package.

PUBLIC RESTROOMS

Public Restrooms are located throughout the course and are marked on the course map.

SECURITY POLICY

Due to recent events and heightened security across our nation, the PGA TOUR and the Travelers Championship have updated the Security Policy to include mandatory screening of all patrons, sponsors, volunteers, media and vendors attending or working the event.

Officials are asking everyone to participate in making the event safe and enjoyable by being aware of their surroundings during their visit to a PGA TOUR event. Should a person see an activity that might be unusual or suspicious, they're urged to notify security personnel or Tournament Official working the event.

Everyone is urged to keep a simple phrase in mind: "See something, say something."

Since the safety and well-being of everyone is of the utmost importance, please adhere to standard tournament policies. Listed below is the outline of the policies and procedures that will be enforced at the Travelers Championship.



Bag Inspection

All items are subject to search. Item inspection will be performed at all Admission Gates while gates are open.

APPROVED BAGS



*Infant and Medical supplies will be permitted after proper inspection.



Prohibited Items

The following items are **PROHIBITED** at the Travelers Championship and must be returned to your vehicle:



No bags larger than a small purse 6"x6" including carrying cases, backpacks, camera bags, or chair bags (See the PGA TOUR Bag Policy for more information: (https://www.pgatour.com/company/tournaments-prohibited-items.html#bagpolicy))



No clear plastic, vinyl, or other carry items larger than 12"x6"x12" (See the PGA TOUR Bag Policy for more information: (https://www.pgatour.com/company/tournaments-prohibited-items.html#bagpolicy))



No glass cups or bottles of any kind except for medical or infant needs



No memorabilia including pin flags, photos, trading cards, balls and other sports paraphernalia



No computers or laptops



No fireworks or laser pointers



No lounge or over-sized chairs with extended foot rests



No seat cushions in a carrying case or that have pockets or compartments



No pets, except for service animals



No knives, firearms or weapons of any nature



No video cameras (All Week)



No point and shoot, film or DSLR cameras (During Competition Rounds)



No selfie sticks or hand-held camera stabilizers



No outside food, beverage or coolers (except for medical or infant needs) (Please see Permitted Items list for details)



No radios, TVs, or portable speakers



No posters, signs or banners



No motorcycles, mopeds, tricycles, bicycles (whether or not motor-driven), skateboards, hoverboards, or other similar devices will be permitted to be operated on or within tournament property. Segways®, motorized scooters or other personal transportation devices are prohibited if not used as a mobility aid by individuals with mobility impairment



No drones, Remote Controlled Model Aircrafts or other devices that can be operated in airspace will be permitted to be operated at PGA TOUR events during tournament week.

Other prohibited items include:

Any other illegal substances or items deemed unlawful or dangerous by the PGA TOUR/Tournament Security Officials.

An exception will be made for fans needing to bring medical supplies into the tournament. These medically necessary items will be permitted after proper inspection at one of the admission gates.

Permitted Items

The following items will be allowed at the tournament:



Personal bags 6"x6" or smaller (See the PGA TOUR Bag Policy for more information (https://www.pgatour.com/company/tournaments-prohibited-items.html#bagpolicy))



Clear plastic, vinyl or other carry items not exceeding 12" x 6" x 12" (See the PGA TOUR Bag Policy for more information (https://www.pgatour.com/company/tournaments-prohibited-items.html#bagpolicy))



A one-gallon clear resealable plastic bag (See the PGA TOUR Bag Policy for more information (https://www.pgatour.com/company/tournaments-prohibited-items.html#bagpolicy))




Outside food and beverage for <u>medical or infant needs only</u>
(Food should be in a clear, resealable plastic bag, not to exceed 1 gallon in size. Infant must be with food.)



Reusable plastic or metal cups/bottles that are empty upon entry and exit, and cannot hold more than 32-ounces



Mobile phones, tablets, and PDA's - MUST be on Silent mode and adhere to TOUR's Mobile Device Policy (See the PGA TOUR Mobile Device Policy for more information





Point and shoot, film or DSLR cameras with lens smaller than 6"; no case (During Practice Rounds Only)



Umbrellas without sleeve



Portable radios with headsets



Medically necessary materials, strollers, small diaper bags, plastic baby bottles, and other essential baby supplies (infant must be with carrier) - items subject to search



Collapsible chairs without chair bags



Binoculars without case






