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## WYNDHAM CLARK WINS \$10,000 FOR CHARITY FROM TRAVELERS IN THE UMBRELLA AT 15 ½ CHALLENGE

Tim Tucker, the caddie for Kitayama, won the caddie closest to the pin competition.
