

# **TRAVELERS CHAMPIONSHIP INTERNSHIP PROGRAM**

The tournament seeks talented college students searching for a dynamic internship experience. Interns will have hands-on experience in a variety of areas that go into organizing a professional sporting event. Roles will include, but are not limited to, sales, tickets, operations and volunteers. Candidates should also be highly motivated, detail-oriented, dependable and a team-oriented self-starter.

# TIME COMMITMENT:

- The nature of this program is that internship hours may be less demanding earlier in the year, with intensity increasing as the tournament nears.
- It is difficult and not recommended to maintain additional employment in May and June leading up to the tournament.
- This internship is a high intensity program and requires an extensive time commitment. We highly encourage students to ask questions during the application and interview process about the commitment level.

Travelers Championship offices are in Hartford, CT & TPC River Highlands in Cromwell, CT.

# TIMEFRAMES:

#### Spring Internship (January – July)

A set schedule is required and will be developed after the student's course schedule is finalized for the Spring Semester. Interns must be available daily once the Spring Semester ends through mid-July and are expected to be available weekends, evenings and special occasions including Memorial Day, Father's Day, and college graduation season. Students may receive course credit during the academic year and a \$2,000 stipend during the summer months.

## Summer Internship (May – July)

Full-Time internships are also available from the end of the Spring Semester– mid-July. Summer interns will be located in either Cromwell or Hartford depending on the intern's area of focus. Interns are expected to be available weekends, evenings and special occasions including Memorial Day, Father's Day and the college graduation season. Students will receive a \$2,000 stipend during the summer months.

To apply for a 2025 internship position in the spring or summer at the Travelers Championship, please submit a cover letter and resume to Taylor via email by **Monday**, **October 28**. Early submission are encouraged, as applications are reviewed on a first-come, first-served basis.
