AWARD-WINNING JOURNALIST HODA KOTB TO HEADLINE 2025 TRAVELERS CHAMPIONSHIP SIGNATURE WOMEN'S DAY BREAKFAST

Event to feature Broadway Star Mary Kate Morrissey

HARTFORD, Conn., May 9, 2025 – The Travelers Championship today announced details for the 2025 Signature Women's Day Breakfast, which will take place Thursday, June 19, at TPC River Highlands. This year's keynote speaker will be award-winning journalist, author and CEO Hoda Kotb, who will take part in an engaging interview following a conversation and short musical performance with special guest Broadway star Mary Kate Morrissey.

Tickets go on sale at 10 a.m. on Tuesday, May 13, at <u>TravelersChampionship.com</u> and will be limited to two per person. Each ticket will include general admission and parking for the tournament's first round of competition. Tickets are expected to be in high demand and will likely sell out quickly.

She joined NBC News in 1998 as a correspondent for "Dateline NBC," and in 2008 she joined "TODAY" as a co-host of the fourth hour alongside Kathie Lee Gifford – a show Kotb recently departed after 17 successful years. She has also been the co-anchor of NBC News' "TODAY" and the co-host of "TODAY with Hoda & Jenna." She is the host of the popular podcast "Making Space with Hoda Kotb," a New York Times bestselling author and has written nine books – her newest book, "Jump and Find Joy," will be released this September. Kotb was inducted into the Broadcasting + Cable Hall of Fame in 2022, and her work has earned her numerous accolades, including multiple Emmy and Gracie Awards.

Mary Kate Morrissey is a musical theater actor, teacher, collaborator and content creator who just finished playing the role of Elphaba in Wicked on Broadway. MK spent a decade touring through 92 cities with Wicked (Elphaba), Mean Girls (Janis) and Hair (Sheila). She's collaborated on work at the Public Theater, Papermill Playhouse, Sundance Lab, Vineyard Arts, The O'Neill, Theatreworks Palo Alto, Portland Center Stage, Signature Theater in DC, and Denver Theater Center. Her work as a creator has been written up in Forbes, Bustle, Washington Post, Golf Digest, Met Golfer and Business Insider.
