TRAVELERS CHAMPIONSHIP INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

The tournament seeks talented college students searching for a dynamic internship experience. Interns will have hands-on experience in a variety of areas that go into organizing a professional sporting event.

Roles will include, but are not limited to, sales, tickets, operations and volunteers.

Candidates should be highly motivated, detail-oriented, dependable, and team-oriented self-starters.

TIME COMMITMENT:

- The nature of this program is that internship hours may be lighter earlier in the year, with intensity increasing as the tournament approaches.
- Maintaining additional employment in May and June is difficult and not recommended.
- This internship is a high-intensity program that requires a significant time commitment. Students are strongly encouraged to ask questions during the application and interview process to fully understand the expectations.

LOCATIONS:

Travelers Championship offices are in Hartford, CT & TPC River Highlands in Cromwell, CT.

OPPORTUNITIES:

Spring Internship (January – July)

A set schedule is required and will be developed after the student's course schedule is finalized for the Spring Semester. **Interns must be available daily once the Spring Semester ends through mid-July and are expected to be available weekends, evenings and special occasions including Memorial Day, Father's Day, and college graduation season.** Students may receive course credit during the academic year and a \$2,000 stipend during the summer months.

Summer Internship (May – July)

Full-Time internships are also available from the end of the Spring Semester– mid-July. Summer interns will be located in either Cromwell or Hartford depending on the intern's area of focus. **Interns are expected to be available weekends, evenings and special occasions including Memorial Day, Father's Day and the college graduation season.** Students will receive a \$2,000 stipend during the summer months.

To apply for a 2026 spring or summer internship with the Travelers Championship, please submit a cover letter and resume to Taylor via email by **Wednesday, October 29**. Early submissions are encouraged, as applications will be reviewed on a rolling, first-come, first-served basis.
