## **‘TODAY’ CO-HOST JENNA BUSH HAGER TO HEADLINE 2026 TRAVELERS CHAMPIONSHIP SIGNATURE WOMEN’S DAY**

*NBC News anchor and meteorologist Dylan Dreyer to emcee event that also features Broadway stars Mary Kate Morrissey and Bella Coppola*

**HARTFORD, Conn., May 15, 2026** – The Travelers Championship today announced details for the 2026 Signature Women’s Day event, which will take place Thursday, June 25, from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. at TPC River Highlands. This year’s keynote speaker will be “TODAY” co-host and bestselling author Jenna Bush Hager, who will take part in an engaging interview following a conversation with and musical performances by Broadway stars Mary Kate Morrissey and Bella Coppola. NBC News anchor and meteorologist Dylan Dreyer will serve as the event’s emcee.

Tickets go on sale at 10 a.m. on Tuesday, May 19, at [TravelersChampionship.com](https://TravelersChampionship.com) and will be limited to two per person. Each ticket will include general admission and parking for the tournament’s first round of competition that same day. Tickets are expected to be in high demand and will likely sell out quickly.

“Our Signature Women’s Day event is meant to inspire and uplift – and this year’s lineup is sure to do exactly that,” said Tournament Director Nathan Grube. “Whether on stage or on screen, Jenna, Mary Kate, Bella and Dylan have each built careers around connecting with people and giving a voice to their stories. We couldn’t be more excited to have them join us this year.”

Travelers is the presenting sponsor of the Signature Women’s Day event. Hartford HealthCare will serve as the supporting sponsor, and The Cigna Group, Enterprise Mobility and Red Thread | Steelcase will be event partners. Net proceeds will benefit tournament charities.

**Jenna Bush Hager** is the co-host of “TODAY with Jenna & Sheinelle” and the founder of the wildly popular Read with Jenna book club, which has introduced millions of readers to breakout authors and bestselling books since its launch in 2019. In 2022, she launched her production company, Thousand Voices, in partnership with NBCUniversal’s Universal Studio Group. She later expanded the brand with Thousand Voices Books, a co-venture with Random House Publishing Group, through which she publishes titles across its imprints. Jenna has written 10 books and is a No. 1 New York Times bestselling author.

**Mary Kate Morrissey** is a musical theater actor, teacher, collaborator and creator who most notably played the role of Elphaba in “Wicked” on Broadway. Her off-Broadway credits include “Joan of Arc: Into the Fire” written by David Byrne, and “Tamar of the River: A World Music Opera.” Regionally, she has starred as Elsa in “Frozen” (Papermill Playhouse), Bev in “Come From Away” (Ogunquit Playhouse), Lizzie in “Lizzie Borden: A Rock Opera” (Portland Center Stage) and Pastor Sharon in “Elmer Gantry” (Signature Theater). In addition to her successful career in theater, she is a passionate and aspiring golfer who has caught the attention of fans and brands in the golf world. Her work as an actor and creator

and her enthusiasm for golf have been spotlighted in Forbes, Bustle, Golf Digest and the Washington Post, and featured on The Golfers Journal podcast, ESPN+, PGA TOUR Live and Quiet Please! With Mel & Kira, among other prominent media outlets.

**Bella Coppola** most recently dazzled New York audiences with her star turn as the original Chloe in the new Broadway production “SMASH: The Musical.” She has also headlined as Jane Seymour in “SIX” on Broadway and in Canada, Pat in “Kinky Boots” off-Broadway and Blanche in “Bonnie and Clyde” at The Rev. Originally from California, Bella moved to Texas to earn her BFA in musical theater at Texas State University before heading to New York City. In addition to her stage credits, Bella is an accomplished recording artist and writer; listen to her original music on all streaming platforms.

**Dylan Dreyer** is the co-host of 3rd Hour of “TODAY” and serves as a weekday weather correspondent and regular co-host for “TODAY” and “Nightly News with Tom Llamas.” Dreyer is also the host of NBC’s “Earth Odyssey with Dylan Dreyer,” the winner of over a dozen Telly Awards. In addition, she co-hosts a weekly radio show on Sirius XM, “Off the Rails,” with fellow “TODAY” co-hosts Al Roker and Sheinelle Jones. You can also often catch her filling in on “NBC Nightly News: Kids Edition” – a digest of the top headlines broken down to help kids better understand the world today. Dreyer is a New York Times bestselling author and a recipient of the American Meteorological Society’s prestigious Seal of Approval award.
