



Ted May made a tremendous impact on the Travelers Championship since the event's beginning – his passing is a profound loss for the broader Connecticut golf community.

From decades of volunteering at the tournament that his father co-founded in 1952, to serving as a past Tournament Chairman and PGA TOUR liaison for 25 years prior to Travelers' title sponsorship in 2007, serving on the Travelers Championship Board of Directors since its inception, and founding The First Tee of Connecticut – Ted's contributions to the game of golf are immeasurable. His influence extended well beyond the state of Connecticut, including having served as President of the American Golf Sponsors Association, served on the PGA TOUR Policy Board, and helped found the First Tee of Morocco. His induction into the Connecticut Golf Hall of Fame was one of many well-deserved honors for a man who gave so much to this game.
